The Civil Work Construction Manager is responsible for supporting the safe execution of construction activities for high-voltage transmission line projects. Responsibilities include field based client relations, project cost and schedule controls, reporting, project monitoring and ensuring sub-contractors meet specific project requirements and contractual obligations.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Schedule Project Scope Execution in logical steps and budgets the time required to meet contracted timelines and customer expectations;
- Determine labor and equipment requirements and coordinates staffing assignments to construction sites, and directs / supervises workers and subcontractors;
- Communicate construction plans and contract terms / conditions to administrative staff, workers, subcontractors, customers, etc.;
- Schedule the delivery of supplies, equipment, tools, etc.;
- Manage work activities against project milestones and coordinates adjustments resulting from inclement weather, unforeseen site challenges, etc.;
- Evaluate construction methods and determine cost-effectiveness of plans / methods to implement continuous improvement practices;
- Prepare and submit management / business data and reports;
- Support Project and Corporate strategies / priorities as requested;
- Work closely with the Project Manager and front line leadership to ensure the civil works packages are carried out in accordance with the prime contract, subcontract and sub-subcontract terms and conditions;
- Work with the civil subcontractors to understand their schedule and ensure the subcontractor is appropriately resourced and fully compliant with subcontract obligations;
- Ensure civil contractor is adhering to the Safety, Quality and Environmental Management Plans. Ensure all work is being appropriately recorded;
- Host daily production meetings with civil subcontractors;
- Report daily progress to the Project Manager and ensure team understands progress to date and issued hindering progress;
- Work with civil subcontractors to provide three week look ahead and work plan for coming weeks;
- Ensure civil subcontractors maintain schedule, including mitigation plans;
- Maintain budgets and schedules which will ensure the successful delivery of the project;
- Maintain updated project schedule by studying project plan and specifications; calculating time requirements; sequencing project elements;
- Control civil work packages costs with the Project Manager and the project team;

- Ensure that civil contractors perform required QC and submit all required forms for the structure files;
- Work with QC staff to source missing civil subcontractor QC forms;
- Other duties may be assigned consistent with job description.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

- A detailed, in depth knowledge and understanding of the civil scope of works, drawings and specifications including specific knowledge of right of way clearing and access construction and grillage and drilled shaft foundation construction means and methods;
- Knowledge of latest industry regulations and standards;
- Detailed understanding of interpreting resource loaded P6 schedules;
- Well organized, fast learner and able to follow instructions;
- Knowledge of transmission and distribution line construction means and methods;
- Excellent attention to detail, even under pressure;
- Ability to analyze technical information;
- Excellent leadership and interpersonal skills;
- Excellent communication skills, both verbal and written;
- Strong analytical and problem solving skills;
- Valid Driver's License is required;
- Ability to travel to and work at project locations situated throughout North America.
